

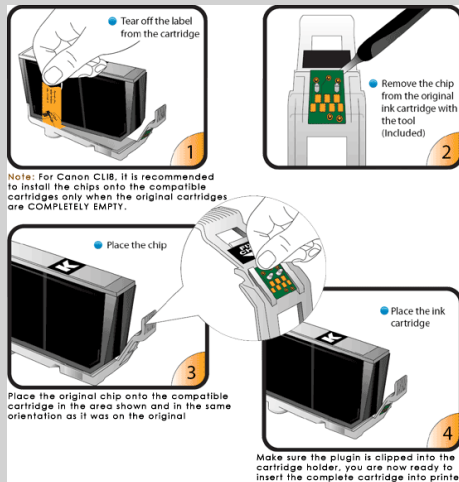

Users can't control the mouse very well

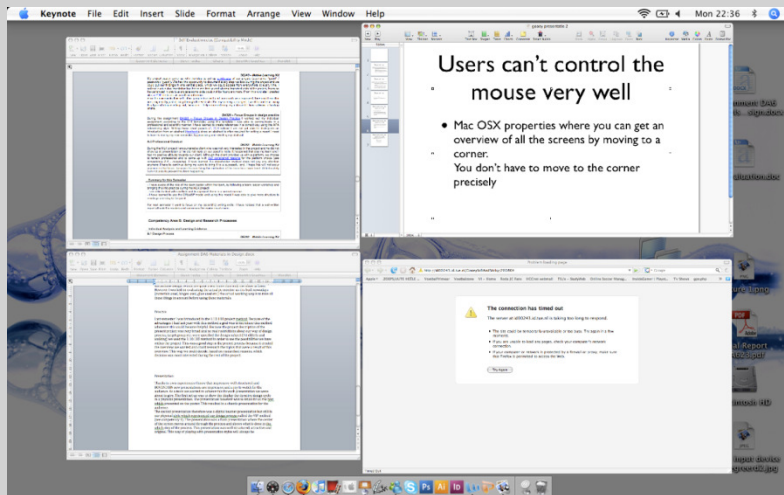
Give buttons larger sizes.

Users can't control the mouse very well

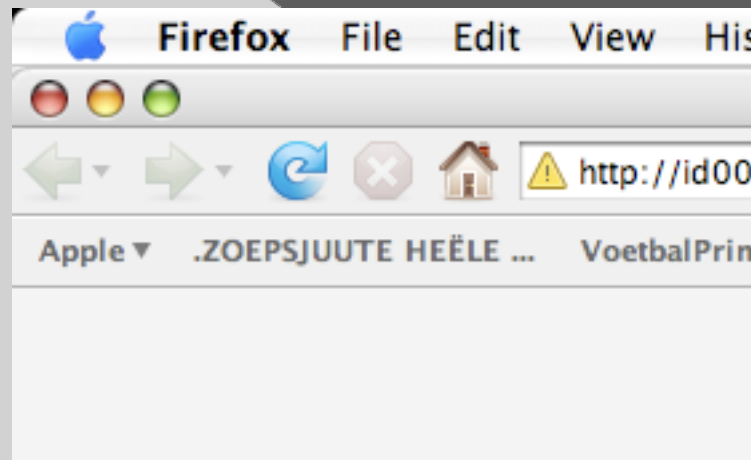
Mac OSX properties where you can get an overview of all the screens by moving to a corner.

The button to close the windows in the MAC operating system.





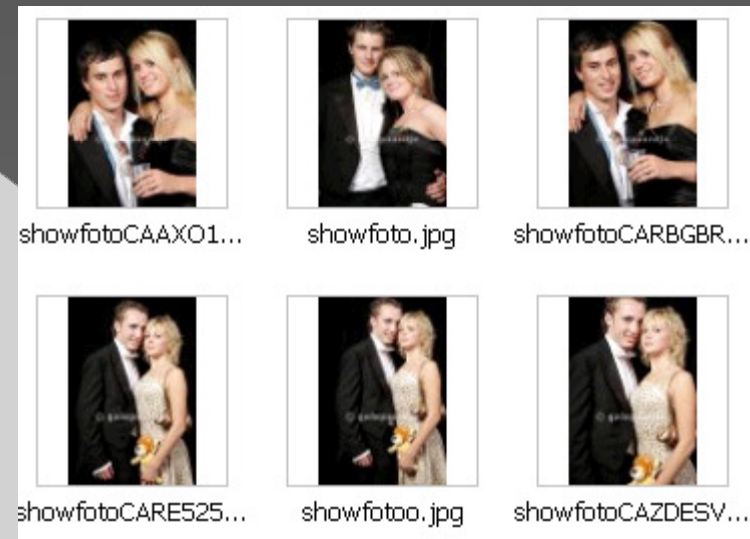
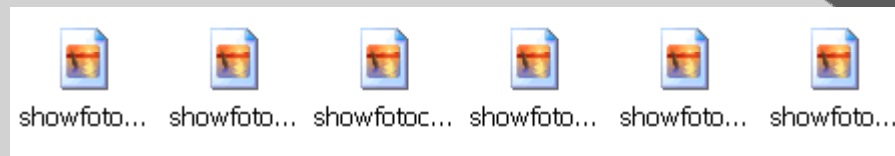
