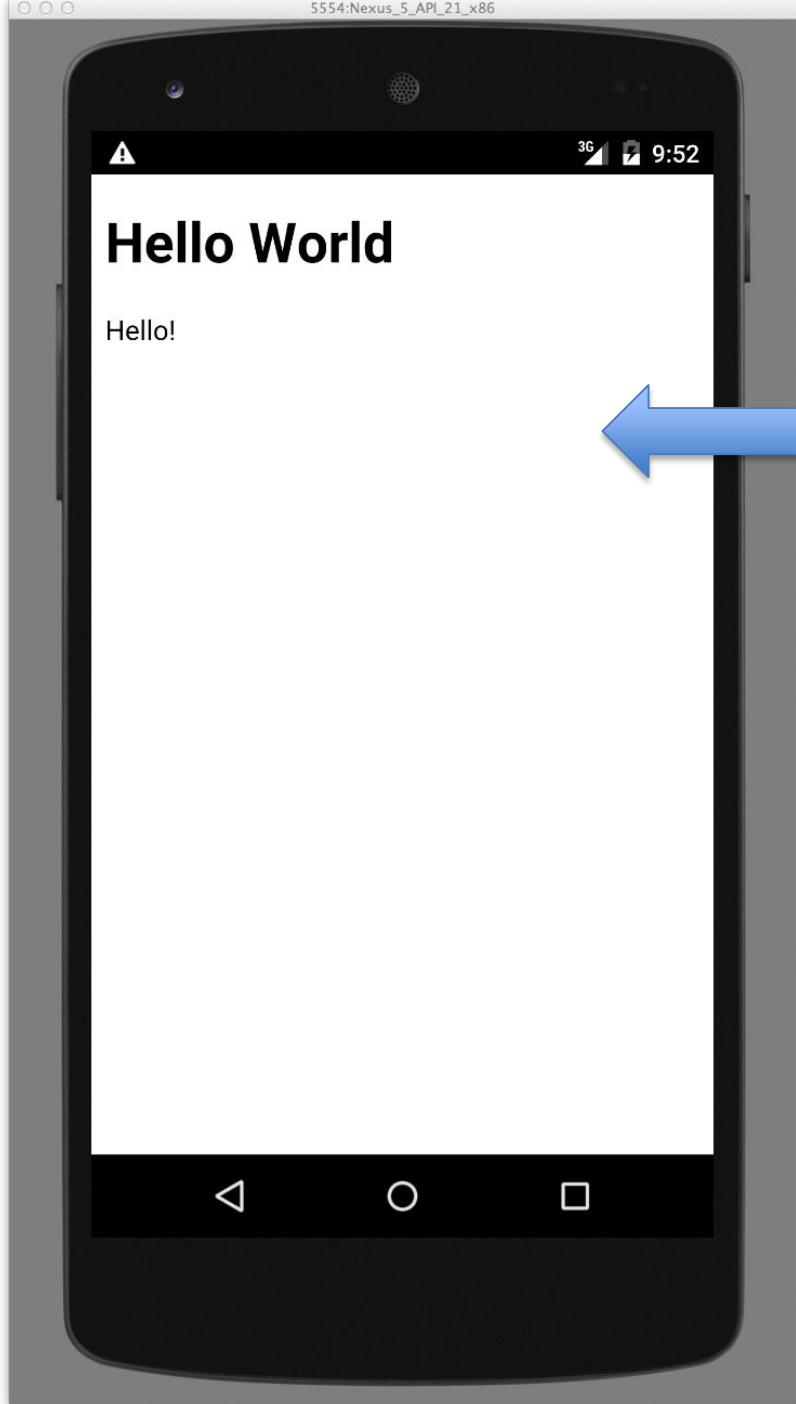

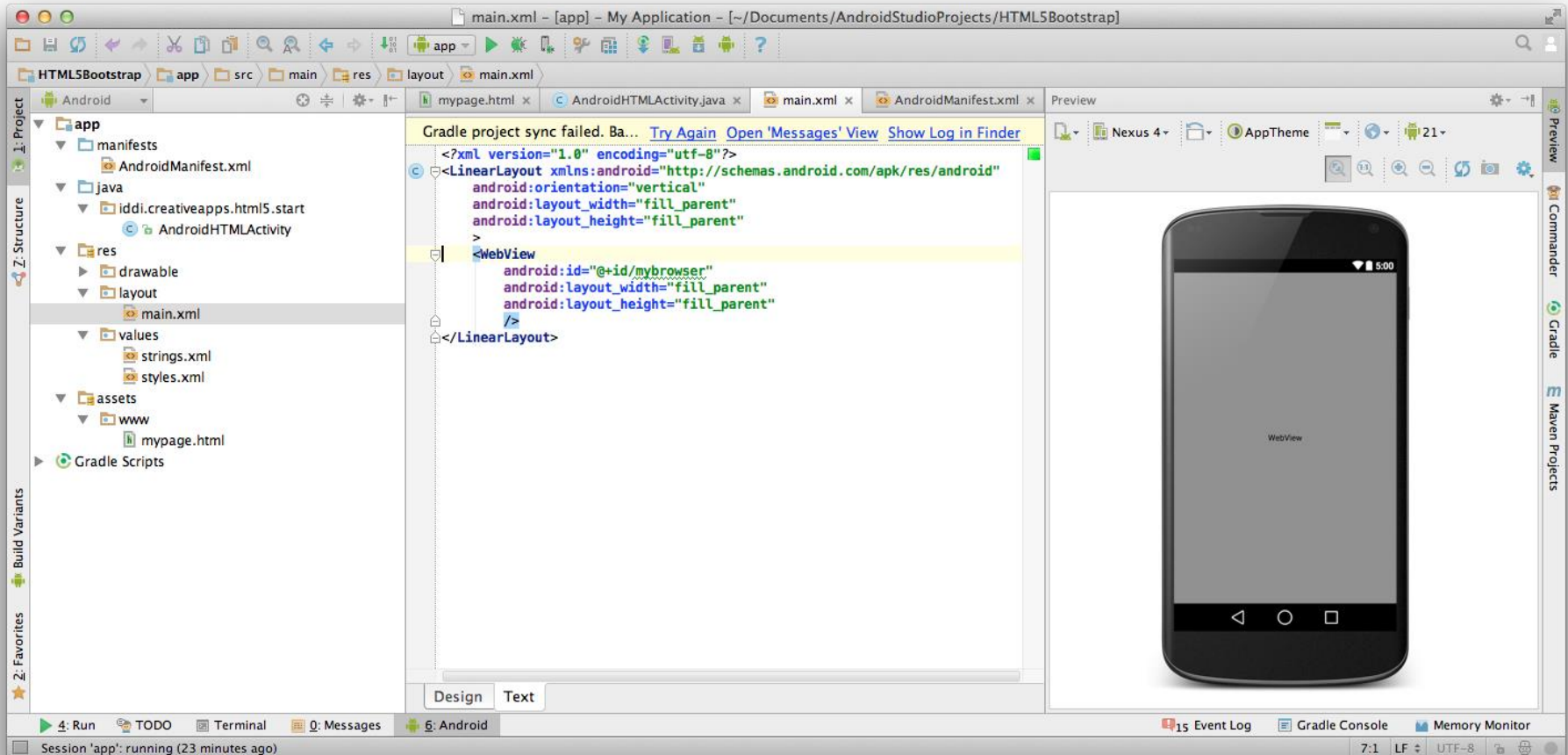
# HTML file

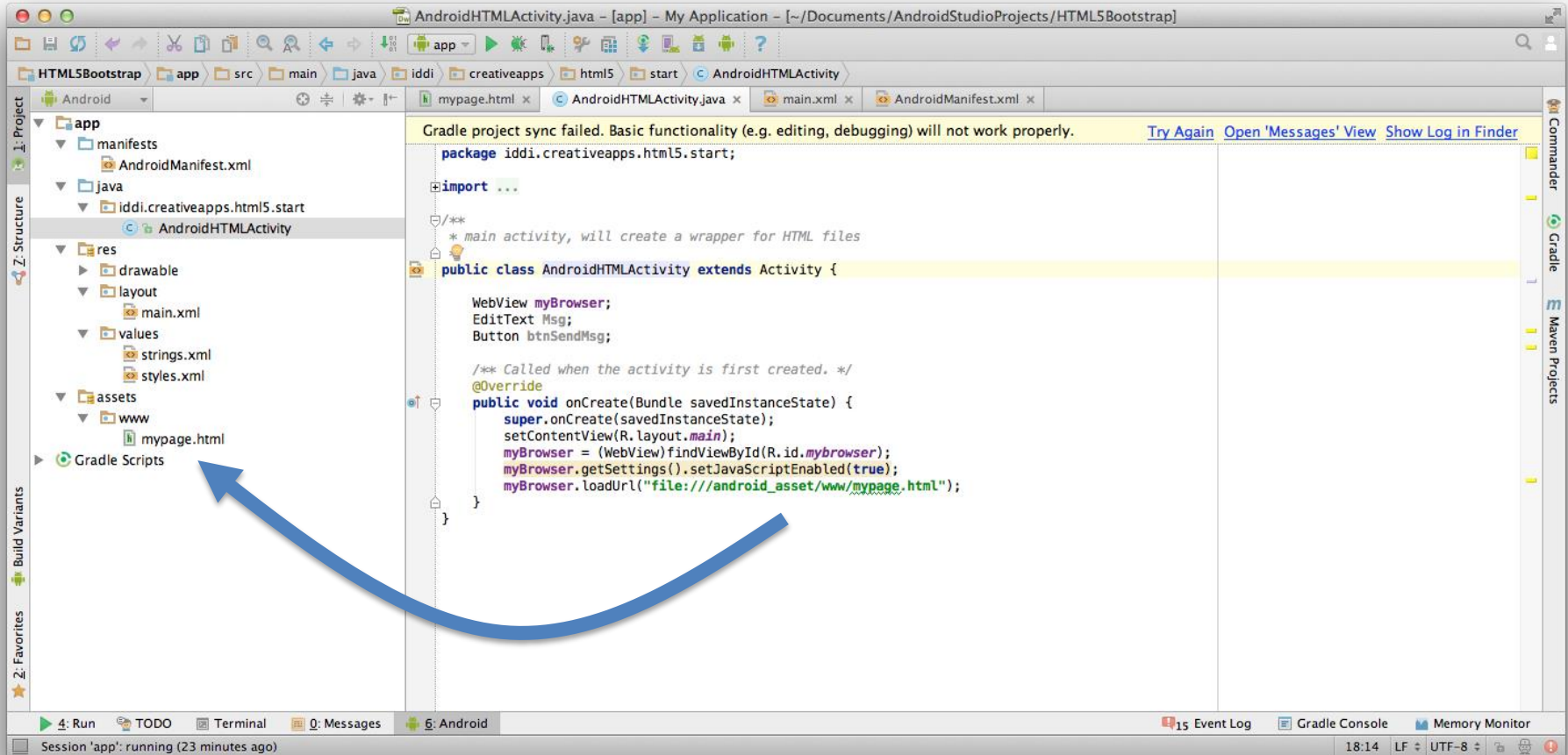

# App layout



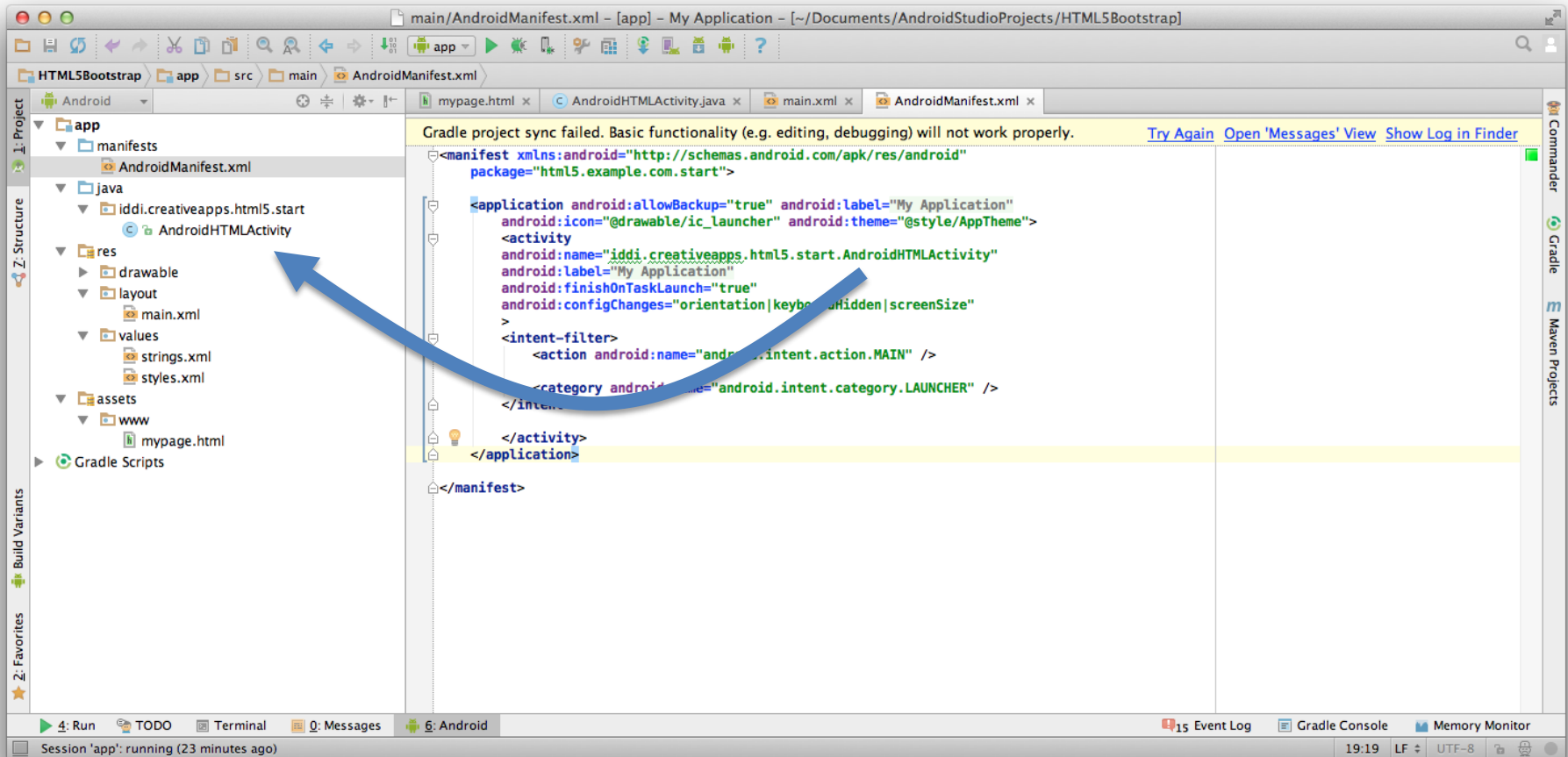
The layout has only one component: a “WebView” that shows the HTML content.
