Tip 1


Phony progress bars are useless if they don't indicate the time well.




Make sure the website fits in the window




Searching on websites is too complicated





 No real problems; users are used to the way Windows works




Results for Ubuntu

- Most were due to the fact that users were used to the way Windows worked and Ubuntu did it slightly different




1 – File overview in explorer






